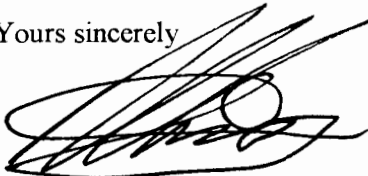
Dear Brian

As a result of the larger scale surveys, some rewriting of descriptions has taken place. I have not provided new forms for these as I think it is up to you whether you consider them necessary! You will see from the report which details have been altered.

However, one complete new shieling, Site 22, and two additions to Site 10, (g & h) have been identified and forms supplied.

The large group of shielings identified last year and given a provisional NG Ref of NM47208525, has now been recorded as Site 21, with a total of 16 separate entries. It was found to be so close to the WGS Area that I have now included them in the remit of the report.
