On the South and East side of the Burn are four structures associated with an abandoned settlement. Consists of a long-house within the heather, aligned WNW - ESE c. 19m x 3m. By the Burn are 2 other structures measuring c. 10m by 3.5m and 8.5m x 3.5m. All three have drystone walls standing to between 0.2m and 0.4m high. The fourth is a sub-rectangular heather clad enclosure defined by small boulders, measuring c. 14m x 5m.
