"(NC 9673 6482) A Pictish sculptured stone, a square sandstone pillar 35% (88.9cms) high and about 9 ins (22.9cms) wide, and not likely to be later than the 8th century, was found in 1947, built into the S wall of Reay Parish Church, and was donated to the NMAS (Acc No: IB 267). The lower part of the shaft is missing. It may be part of a cross-shaft, or a completely new type of monument, a squared pillar-stone." (1) (2).

7. PICTISH SCULPTURE FROM REAY.

In 1947, when the south wall of Reny Parish Church, Caithness, was being stripped of old plaster, a sculptured stone was found built into it. After consultation with the Ministry of Works, the Kirk Session have added this most interesting stone to the National Museum.

It consists of a square pillar of reddish sandstone 35½ inches high, the bottom broken, however. Each side is about 9 inches wide. The decoration, as can be seen in Plate XXV, is flat relief, executed by harimering or "pocking." On the front there is a cross with a square expansion at the top, covered with a diagonal key pattern. On the right side there are successively from top to bottom a more than hemispherical blank boss, a hound (snapping at the stag round the corner), a standing cow wearing a bell, a kneeling cow, a horse trotting in the opposite direction from the other animals, and lastly a plain surface. The cows have crudely incised joint spirals with long stems. On the left side is a stout running spiral that had formed four roundels, of which one has been chiselled off. The top of the pillar has also been chiselled, and there is a dowel hole sunk in the back, all no doubt done at some relatively recent time.

Though roughly executed and in rather a decadent Pictish animal style, the Though roughly executed and in rather a decadent Pictish animal style, the Reay stone is unlikely to be much later than the eighth century. The fine relief from Papil, Shetland, found in 1943,⁴ also presumably datable to before the Viking occupation, shows a free-standing cross probably very early in the Iona-Scottish series. The Reay pillar might thus be part of the shaft of a cross, though one has not been found before in the north. On the other hand, a cross is prominent in part of the sculptural design, and we may have a new type of monument, a squared pillar-stone.
