* The stone inside the Mackay Aisle, Reay, on the left side, is in memory of Angus Mackay of Bighouse, great-great-grandfather of Louisa.

Note: this stone 1687, and the Munro stone 1691, could have been placed in the walls of this tiny church building to indicate four of the earlier burials within its walls. And how many more were to follow (?) including David Mackay, Minister, and Elizabeth Sage Mackay.

Jas Black, fa John, mo Margt Tod, w Janet Mackay 10.1830 50,
s Colin (w Eliz Forbes, da Mary)

This means that James Black's parents were John Black and Margaret Tod, his wife was Janet Mackay who died in October 1830 aged 50 and his son was Colin. Relationship is to the person first named. Relationship within brackets is to the name immediately before the brackets so Colin's wife is Elizabeth Forbes and they had a daughter named Mary. Relationship groups are separated by a semi-colon ; uncertain readings are in square brackets or with a question mark.

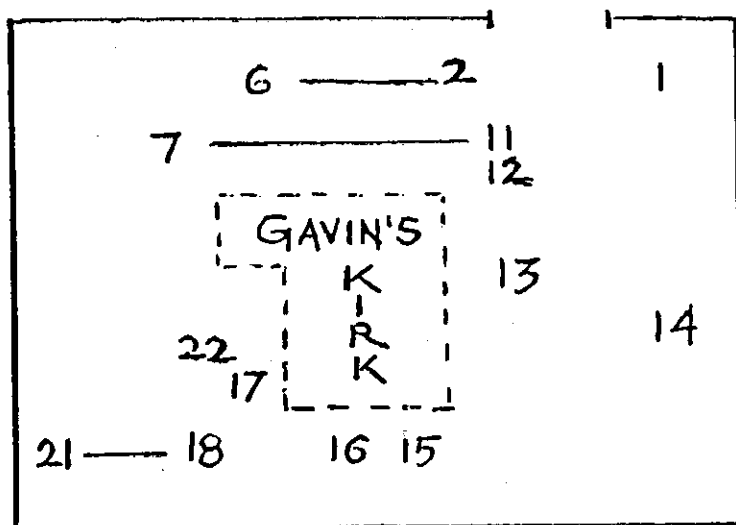

OLD PAROCHIAL RECORDS : CAITHNESS

The old parish registers of the Church of Scotland for Caithness covering 1652 - 1854 are in the New Register House, Edinburgh, and may be consulted on payment of a fee. Microfilm of these registers are in the Clan Sutherland Society room at Dunrobin Castle (fee charged). The registers are mainly for births and marriages though there are a few death registers .

CENSUS RECORDS 1841 - 1891 are in New Register House, Edinburgh.

DORRERY : B 870 approx. 2 miles north of Scotscalder Station turn west at crossroads; at next junction take road on left and travel by south end of Loch Calder to Dorrery Lodge gates where road ends. Cross field (about 1/4 mile) on left and south east of farmhouse and lodge : the railway line is seen to the south. A low stone wall encloses the burial ground and the ruins of Gavin's kirk now a line of tumbled stones.

THE MACKAY AISLE

This is the reconstructed remains of part of the old Reay Church: interior area 16'2" x 11' 8".

INTERIOR:

These monuments are set into the walls -

1. Geo Mackay, Bighouse, Lt Col Reay Hlrs d Scotstown near Edinburgh 1798 61, ed officers, soldiers of that Regt on service Longford, Ireland.
Note: Each man gave four days pay to pay for this memorial. Mackay died at his brother's house at Scotstown near Peebles on 6 Sep 1798. Over the entrance to the Scotston aisle at Newlands Churchyard, Peebles-shire there is a memorial tablet to George Mackay of Bighouse: his brother Aeneas is also buried at Newlands.
2. Memorial tablet:
Rev Alexander Pope, M.A. minister Reay 1734 to death 1782
Note: Pope died 2.3.1782 - no stone was erected over his grave.
3. Sculptured stone:
2 hearts with saltire between them; below 2 heraldic shields - Mackay and Sinclair; inscription - --- e belon --- Ang ---Ma --- ighou
Note: the inscription records that the aisle belongs to Angus Mackay of Bighouse. He was married to a Sinclair.
4. Sculptured stone: M
heraldic shield - Munro : D M M M 1691
Note: the inscription records that a fourth part of this aisle belongs to Mr David Munro and Margaret Munro.
4. Sculptured stone:
an ancient grey sandstone slab with ornamental cross - key pattern and circular knot work; added 18thc inscription - Robert McKay 17--
Note: till c1911 this historic stone was used in the burial ground as a grave stone.

These fine stones and the Mackay monument are suffering from neglect and damp.

EXTERIOR:

Tablet set into west wall:

Rev Finlay Cook, 1st FC minr Reay, previously parish church, d 12.6.1858 80, w Eliz Sage 14.10.1838 58, ed s Alex FC minr Stratherrick Inverness-shire 1859.

Note: Mr Cook was one of the outstanding ministers of the church before and after the Disruption: his wife was a sister of Donald Sage, author of Memorabilia Domestica.

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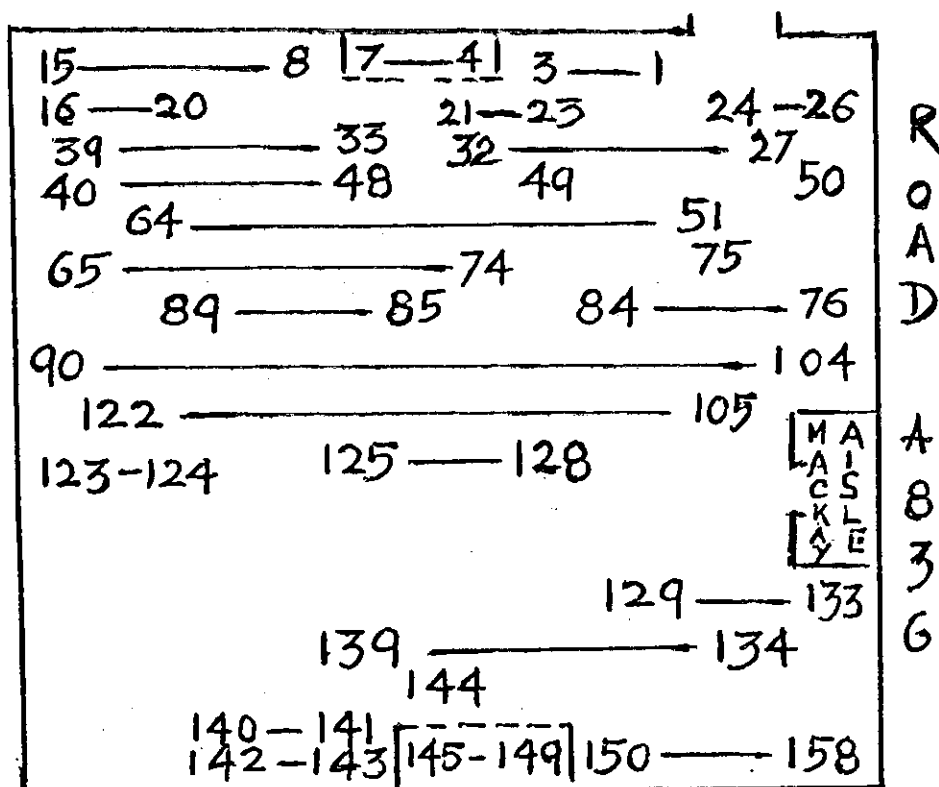

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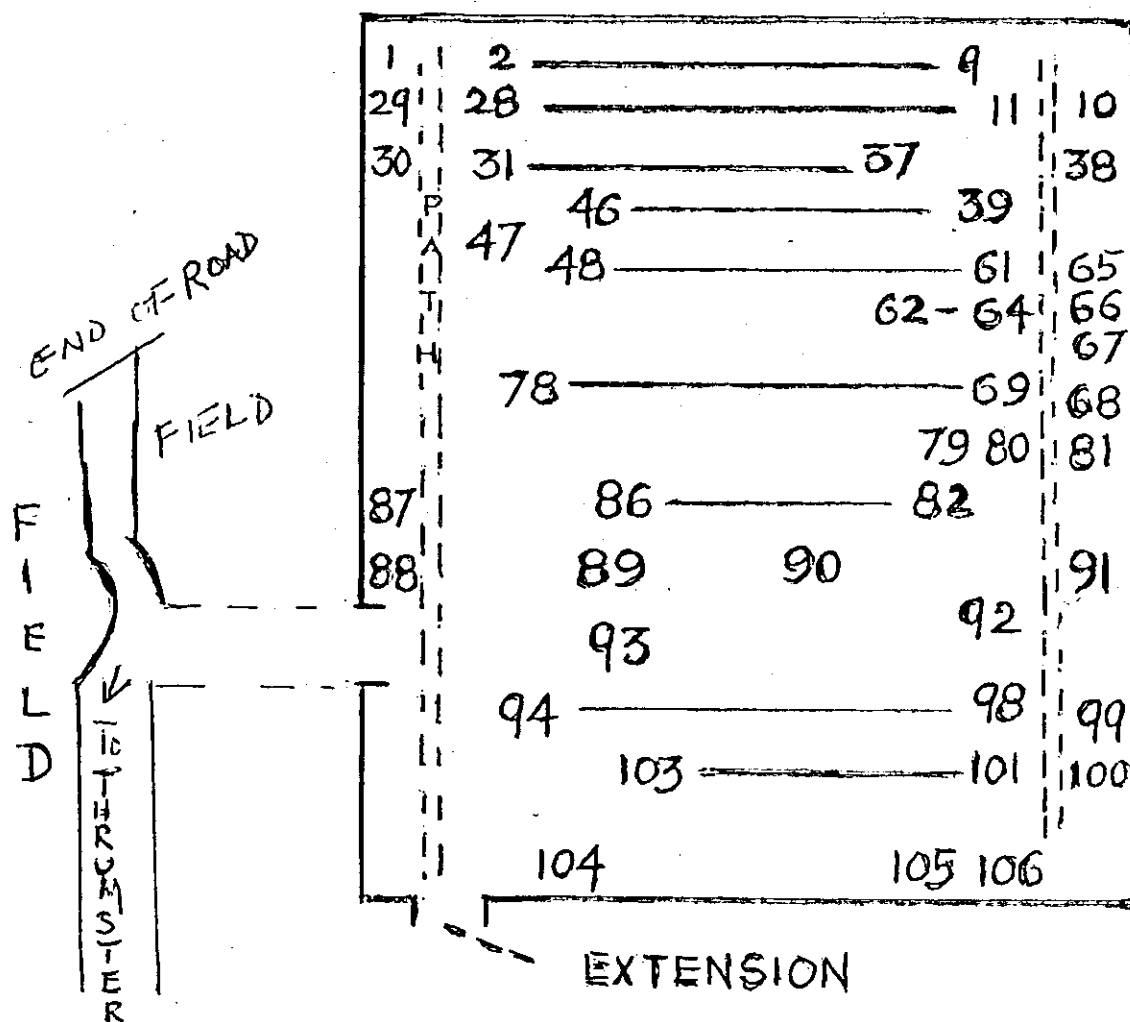
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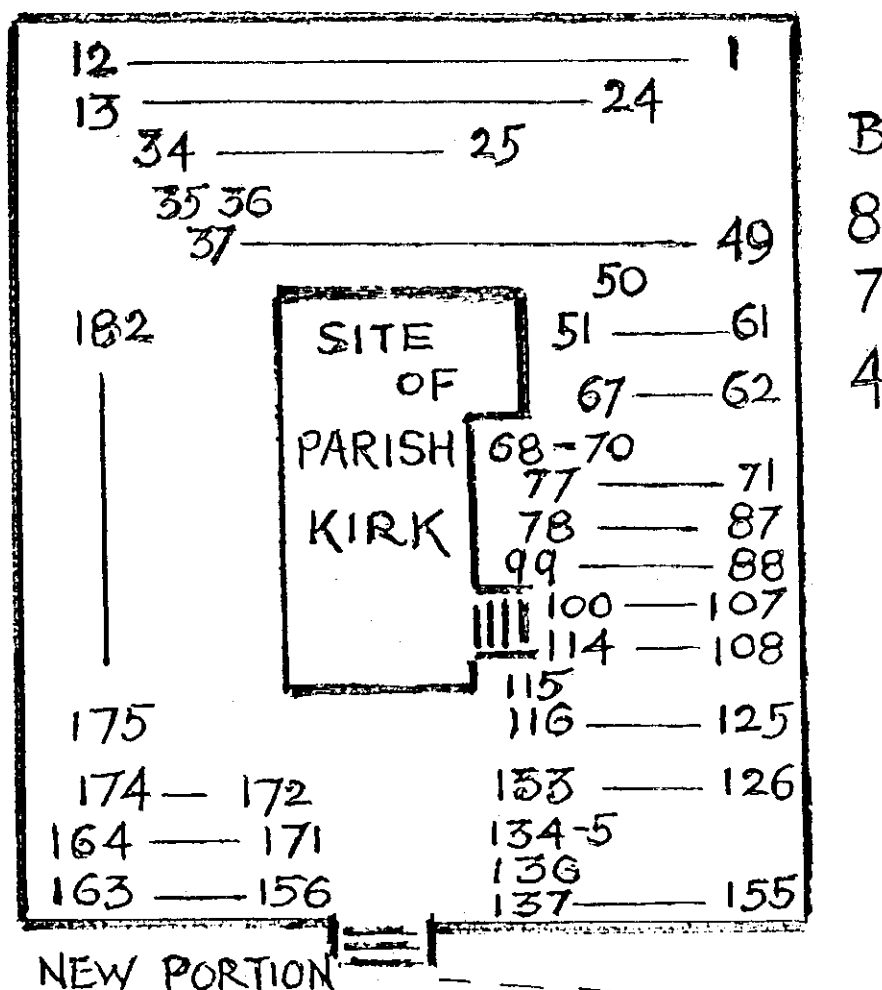
