"(ND 0800 5598) Mound." (1)

"Hut Foundation, Cnoc Scoot; On the S end of a low ridge, about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile N by E of Dorrery Lodge, is a small rectangular enclosure lying E-W and measuring some 5 ft by 3 ft, surrounded by a broad low turf bank. The ends of the interior are faced with slabs set on edge about 10 ins above ground and on the S side building is visible. An entrance passage 2 ft wide and $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft in length leads into the enclosure at the SE angle. The construction measures about 25 ft in diameter over all." (2).

"This is a grass-covered cairn, 10.7m in diameter and 0.6m high. In the top of the mound and oriented E-W is a cist, 1.7m by 0.9m by 0.4m deep. A small passage leads S from the SE end of the cist; it is 1.9m long by 0.6m wide. (OSFI:WDJ:10.4.1962).

442. Cairn. Dimensions: 11m x 9m. Height: 1m. Subcircular grass-covered mound with a central cist oriented E-W. Cist measures 1.75m x 1m, and is 0.75m deep, and is lined with orthostats. A passage 2.25m long and 0.75m wide, leads to the cist on the S side. On hill top. Elevation: 300' OD. ND 080560. O.S. Card ND 05 NE 23. RCAHMS (1911) Caithness, 43, No. 155. (Fig. 17)
