## 52 TEXT

"At ND 0266 6111 there is a largely turf-covered hut circle set into a gentle SE-facing slope. It measures about 8.0m in diam within a wall spread 1.5 to 2.0m and 0.5m high. The entrance is in the ESE; a band of stone extends outwards from the N side of the entrance passage for 2.0m. A stony scarp in the interior suggests a sub-division. A small number of clearance heaps, short stretches of wasted walling and linear clearance are evidence of contemporary cultivation around the hut."
