

Objects found during surface collection around the broch mound by Robert Stephen-Murray. Retained by finder.

1. Bronze lump (ingot?) of d-shaped section, tapering towards one end. Double ridge and groove along 'spine', flat base. Found 'on ground surface' c. 2 metres distant from broch mound, west side. Found April 1991.
2. 4 flat bronze 'washer'-like objects, between 2.5 - 3.0 cm diameter. Found 'on surface' adjacent to gerston Broch. With finder. Found early 1991.
3. 3 large, apparently worked, sandstone flakes of large size. Perhaps ardpoints. (see drawings). With finder. Found 'On surface' 1991.



IN CENTRE








SOME WEAR AT POINT
