IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

To Thrumster Estates Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts and having their registered office at Bridge Street, Wick, the owners of the Monument known as Cairn Reain occupying an oval area of ground measuring forty yards at its greatest length from east to west and twenty yards at its greatest width from north to south, the westmost point of said area being situated twenty yards east of the north-eastmost corner of North Yarrows farm buildings, eighty yards north by west of the north shore of the Loch of Yarrows at its nearest point and one hundred and twenty yards south by east of the road between Thrumster and Brickigoe at its nearest point,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as North Yarrows Croft situated in the Parish of Wick and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

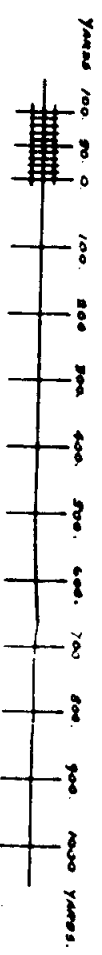
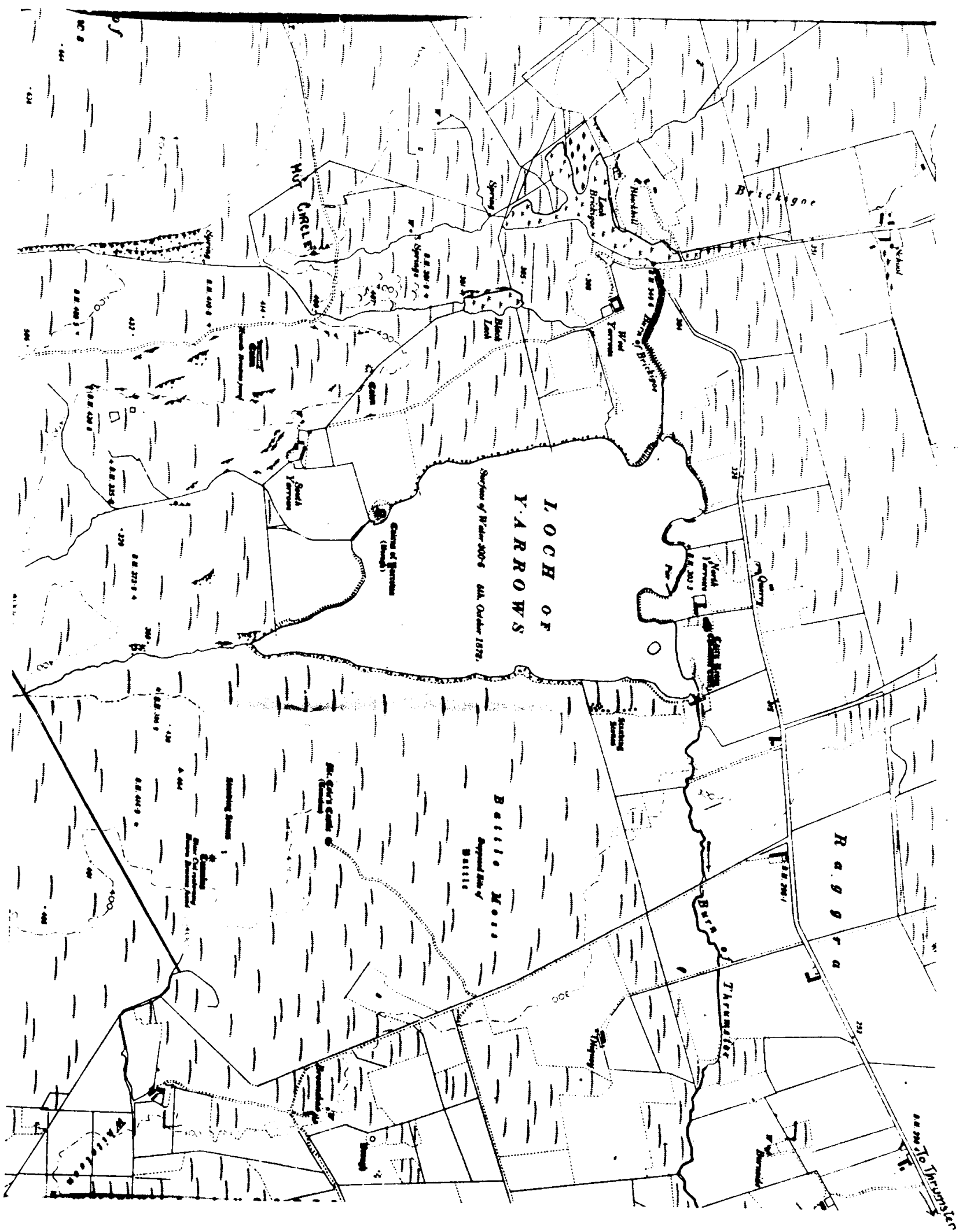
