This site has been brought to my attention through a nearby Planning Application. While the site is scheduled, it was destroyed in 1940 during the construction of Skitten aerodrome, and I would assume that ancillary structures were also destroyed. Unless its association with Sir Francis Tress Barry, who excavated at the site in 1904, and Calder, who carried out subsequent excavations in 1940 immediately prior to destruction, I see no reason why this site should now remain on the list of Scheduled Monuments, and would recommend that it be de-scheduled.

I would appreciate your comments or those of your colleagues on this matter, and look forward to hearing from you.


