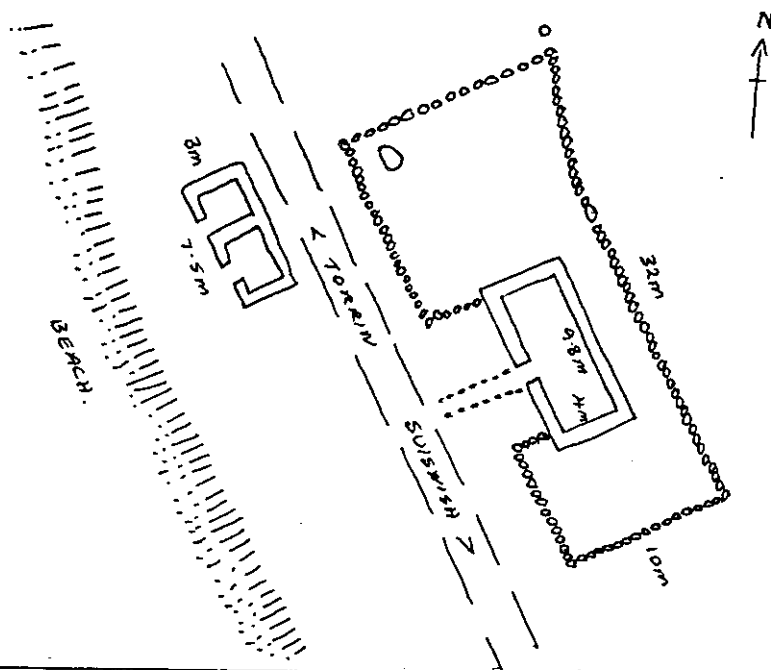

House, byre & enclosure														

Lying at the foot of the slope by the east side of the track to Suisnish and facing the open sea, are the ruinous remains of a well built stone house.

The remains measure 9.8 m N-S by 4.0 m E-W over walls 1 m thick, a door opening lies in the centre of the west side facing the sea. A garden enclosure with a wall containing many very large boulders lies on three sides of the house being attached only to the NW and SW front corners, leaving the front of the house open to the sea.

On the opposite side of the road are the ruins of a byre type building which measures 7.5 m N-S by 3 m E-W over walls 0.6 m thick, an internal partition divides the building in half and each half has a door way in the centre of its west/sea facing side.
