"Leave Coire-chattachan (the old mansion house of the MacKinnons NG 62 SW 12) wind along the bottoms of the steep hills. Pass by the end of Loch Slappan to the south. See a stone dyke or fence called Paraicnam fiadh, or the enclosure of the deer, which seems once to have been continued up a neighbouring hill. In one angle is a hollow ... a pit fall (formerly) covered with boughs for the destruction of the animals chased into it." (1)
