## 52 TEXT

"Some 30yds(27.52m) from the right bank of Lonfearn Burn, and about 250yds(229.0m) NE of the bridge which crosses it about 1/4 mile S of Culnaknock, is a hut circle measuring 12'(3.7m) in diameter within 3'(0.9m) wide stone wall, 6"(0.15m) - 1'6"(0.45m) high."(1) "NG 5172 6223 hut circle."(2) "NG 5172 6223. Hut circle as described by RCAHM, in poor condition. It is situated within an area of lazy-beds which avoid it."(OSFI:AC:1.5.1961) "NG 5195 6210 lonfearn."(3)

"The foundation of a sub-circular structure consisting of a boulder-faced wall 0.9m thick and measuring c.5.5m in diameter overall. It is not a hut circle and is probably contemporary with depopulated structures to the N."(OSFI:AA:4.11.1971) "There were formerly vestiges of cairns and circles near Lonfearn farmhouse at a place called Totagan Nan Druidhean = Little Knoll of the Druids."(1) no.569 (4)(5)
