The remains of Dun a Chleirich occupy the summit of a small rocky peninsular on the sea-shore. It is reached (2) by a narrow neck on the N.W. or landward side, which stands about level with the fort. Towards the sea, where it is rocky but not precipitous, it reaches a height of 50 ft. above the beach. It is defended by a stone wall, (15 now very dilapidated, built round the edge of the summit and following the sinuosities of the rock. Internally the dun measures some 52 ft. NW-SE, and 51 ft. NE-SW. (15 In some places the outer face of the wall shows 3 ft.in, height, but generally it is very dilapidated. On the N.W. towards the land, the wall has been of considerable strength, as it now shows a rough mound of stones, 20 ft. 
