Lying in a very exposed position high above the west bank of the Allt na Peighinn and overlooking an area of rig cultivation on the east bank of the burn are the ruinous remains of two structures being:-

1. A sub-rectangular house, its SE end being rectangular with a central door-way while the NW is rounded with a radius of 3 m overall dimensions are 10.5 m NW-SE by 5.1 m NE-SW over walls 1.1 m thick.
 2. The second structure lies 18 m to the north and is of circular construction 9.5 m in diameter over walls 1.4 m thick. This structure is much more ruinous than (1) and may be considerably older.
- A short length of turf dyke lies 20 m to the east and runs along the edge of the
