52 TEXT

"Centred at NH 460 503 on a south-facing slope is a settlement of 12 hut circles ('A'-'M') and a contemporary field system." (OSFI:ISS:12.4.1973)

"All the huts are circular except 'C', 'G' and 'M' which are oval. Walls are generally spread between 2.5m and 3.5m."

" 'A', 'B', 'D' and 'E' and visible as circular platforms measuring 11.0m in diameter with a few stones protruding around the perimeters."

" 'C' is an ill-defined oval platform measuring 15.0m E-W by 13.0m."

" 'F' is well-defined by a wall of bare stones, though no definite facing stones are evident, and measures 11.5m in diameter between wall centres. The entrance is in the ESE."

52. " 'C' is well-defined measuring 11.0m NNW-SSE by 9.0m between wall centres. The entrance is in the SSE."
- " 'J' is well-preserved and measures 13.0m between wall centres. The entrance is in the E."
- " 'K' is an ill-defined platform, 11.5m in diameter with a few stones visible around the perimeter."
- " 'L' is a platform, 12.5m in diameter with occasional outer facing stones visible. The ill-defined entrance is in the SE."
- " 'M' is heavily mutilated, measures 13.0m NW-SE by 11.5m between wall centres. The mutilated entrance is in the SE."
- "The field system is marked by stone clearance heaps, lynchets, and one or two ruinous walls."
- "Huts surveyed at 1/10,000."
- "Field system delineated on 1/10,000."
