Corriegarth Lodge

Further to our telephone conversation this morning, I am sending some information regarding the above property. The approximate grid reference is NH 5217, and the address is Corriegarth Lodge, Gorthleck, Inverness. I have marked on the OS map the area where we would be most likely to do some excavation in order to create a small pond, and also the points from which the photographs were taken.

The only other plans for this field are the planting of trees, probably in clumps which would later be thinned. The species would include birch, aspen, rowan, Scots pine, sycamore and larch, and the aim is to frame the views rather than to create a block of woodland.

We would welcome any further information on the 'Settlement and Field System' of a particular or general nature, and any advice on where we should be careful to conserve anything of archeological interest.
