Description, notes Boulder A 9993 2607 Boulder B 9994 2640. "A" A boulder measuring 2.8m in length, 2m in width & 1.6m high. The East face of the boulder is flat & contains at least 43 cup marks. "B" A boulder measuring 1.9m in length, 1.3m in width & 0.4m high. The top is flat & contains 9 cup marks. At 9995 2585 is a huge mass of mica schist almost earth fast. The top is flatish 3.6m - 4.3m across & contains 53 cup marks. On the ridge extending south east ^{west} from Laggan Hill there are 2 cup marked boulders & 6 rock outcrops with cup marks.
