**ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ANCIENT MONUMENTS GRANTS  
CORRIEYAIRACK PASS, MILITARY ROAD, LAGGAN TO FORT AUGUSTUS**

On behalf of the Scottish Ministers I hereby offer to make a grant to you the said Speyside Trust for the purpose of defraying in whole or in part the expenditure incurred or to be incurred by you in the repair or maintenance of the Subjects (as hereinafter defined) on the following terms and conditions. The standard conditions of grant annexed and executed as relative hereto are hereby incorporated into this offer.

By accepting this offer of grant you will also be deemed to have received Scheduled Monument Consent for the works outlined in Annex 2 under the terms of The Ancient Monuments (Class Consents) (Scotland) Order 1996. However, any additional works affecting the scheduled monument not referred to in Annex 2 will require a separate application for Scheduled Monument Consent.

**1. Definitions**

Unless the context otherwise requires, in this Offer the following expressions shall have the following meanings:-

| 1.2 "the Subjects" | means the subjects known as and forming Corrieyairack Pass, military road, Laggan to Fort Augustus |



1.3 “the Total Grant Eligible Costs”

means THIRTY FOUR THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY TWO POUNDS AND FIFTY PENCE STERLING (£34,442.50) or such other sum as the Scottish Ministers acting reasonably, considers represents the Grant Eligible Costs incurred by the Grantee after having carried out an inspection of the Approved Scheme when complete and after having examined the final account for carrying out the Approved Scheme.

1.4 “the Completion Deadline” means 31 July 2009

1.5 “the Final Account Deadline”

means 31 July 2009

2. The Grant

2.1 The Grant to be made by Scottish Ministers to the Grantee shall (subject to Condition 3 of the Standard Conditions of Grant) be the lesser of:

(a) TWENTY NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY TWO POUNDS AND FIFTY PENCE STERLING (£29,442.50); or

(b) 85.48% of the Total Grant Eligible Cost

3. Conditions of grant

The following conditions will attach to the award of the grant:

3.1 there shall be no deviation from the works as described in document ‘Corrieyairack Emergency repairs 2009’.

*Reason; to ensure that the works are carried out to an agreed standard.*

3.2 A photographic record of the areas of road in question before, during and after the works shall be compiled, titled and their location accurately cross referenced and submitted to Historic Scotland **within 8 weeks** of the completion of the path works. The annotated photographs shall also be deposited within the National Monuments Record of Scotland, John Sinclair House, 16 Bernard Terrace, Edinburgh, EH8 9NX and the sites and Monument Record of Highland Council, Highland Council Archaeology Planning and Development Services, Council HQ, Glenurquhart Road, Inverness, IV3 5NX.

*Reason; to ensure that an accurate record of changes to the monument is maintained and is widely available to the general public.*

3.3 The applicant shall inform Historic Scotland of the completion of the works in writing.

*Reason; to allow an Historic Scotland Representative to visit to ensure that works are carried out to an agreed standard.*

#### 4. Public Access

The Grantee will arrange that on completion of the repair work members of the public will be granted access to the monument.



## 5. Time Limit for Acceptance

This offer shall be open for acceptance in writing within one month after the date of offer and failing acceptance on or before that date shall thereafter be deemed to have been withdrawn.
