The memorial appears to be mounted on a holdfast for gun - steel ring with threaded bolts. There was a WWI gun battery near here so possibly part of that.

Concrete base 12 ft x 12 ft (3680 x 3680 MM)

Steel ring approximately 67" 1700MM diameter, ring 11" 280MM wide.

Threaded studs 1.5" diameter 2.75" high  
23" / 580MM apart
