

#### Introduction

The church at Dunlichity is situated 2 miles north from the village of Farr, and lies in the parish of Daviot and Dunlichity in the district of Inverness. It formerly was in the area of Nairnshire but area boundaries were changed in 1891. It has served as the parish church for over 200 years. Inhumations have taken place here from its earliest beginnings and continue to the present day.

**Church History** 

The parishes of Daviot and Dunlichity were united in 1618. To when a church was established at Dunlichity is unknown. The Third Statistical Account records that the original church was situated near Brinmore (Barron, 1985,42). It is known that the church had been built by 1702, as a handbell of this date is kept in the present churches' vestry.

The present church was built in 1759 for 300 persons to replace an earlier one, fragments of which may survive as the adjoining burial ground. It was repaired in 1787 at a cost of £25, again in 1826 and altered again in 1829 and in 1859. The stipend of the church in 1781 was £52.6s, and raised by a further £25 in 1784. By 1814 this was now 12 chalders of victual, half barley and half meal.

In 1882 it was recorded that a cup-marked stone of 38 cups, re-used as a gravestone was to be seen in the churchyard (Jolly 1882, 372-373), but by the Ordnance Survey of 1970 is was noted to be missing.

## **Church Records**

Although there is no records of deaths or burials, those of births exist from 1774 to 1854, whilst those of marriages exist from 1774 to 1836, but they are plagued with irregularities. In the births from 1781 to 1810, records of whole families are grouped together, some dated after 1820. Those for 1796 to 1813 are after the record of 1819. Whilst births for 1797 to 1825 come after marriages for 1780. There is only 7 entries for marriages between 1791 and 1804. And for the period March 1780 to June 1815 there are no marriage records.

Records were maintained before 1774, but these were lost when the school, where they were stored was burnt down.

In the Kirk of Session Library, Edinburgh minute books exist from 2 April 1771 to 7 May 1835, with the exception of those from 10 December 1788 to 7 May 1834.

# Ministers of the Church

Only one minister of the parish is commemorated by a memorial in the churchyard. The number in brackets denotes their stone number. 1922 - 1936 Rev. Alistair MacLean. (292)

#### **Church Fabric**

The church is rectangular in plan, harled with a slate roof and incorporates earlier walling. This walling has been suggested by Gifford (1992, 165) to be medieval in date but this is probably unlikely. A chancel arch in the east gable, formerly a door is now blocked. Rectangular windows on north and south sides, with two pointed windows at the west gable. Atop the west gable is the remains of an ashlar belicote, possibly built in the 1820's, now surmounted by an iron cross.

The building is quite altered, due to its various repairs over a period of time. A rectangular mort/watch house of dressed sandstone and slate roof to south gate.

#### **Date and condition of Monuments**

The memorials in the churchyard date from the late 18th century to the modern day. They are in a variety of styles including slabs (both plain & effigy), obelisks, pedestals and headstones. The vast majority are in good condition, only a few being damaged or broken or quite worn by weathering. Most of the headstones are set upright in a bed of concrete, to help and stabilise them. It is noted by Gifford (1992,165) that there is a possible 17th century heraldic graveslab in the burial enclosure to the east of the church, but only an 18th C. slab was noted.

Recording Form

For the purposes of this survey a recording form was devised based on that recommended by the Council for British Archaeology (Jones 1984). This form being quite detailed (see over), and possibly difficult to use, a simplified form detailing the most important points of recording was drawn up. (see over) This was to include the following:-

1. Full inscription, including all genealogical information.

2. Type and style of monument.

3. Orientation and size.

4. Material used.

5. Photograph: a colour print (4x5) for attachment to each recording form. Also that details of carvings or other comments could be recorded.

# Key to Recording Form

1st line - Date of Record - day upon record made;

- Recorder - initials of person making record;

- Memorial No. - number of stone relating to plan;

2nd line - Monument type - what kind of monument is it? headstone/slab/etc;

3rd line - Material - What it is made of pink/yellow sandstone, granite, slate, etc;

4th line - Faces Inscribed (Compass Points) - What direction does the inscription

5th line - Condition of stone & inscription - overall is the stone and inscription together very good, good, very poor, or poor. Take into consideration the eligibility of the inscription and the stone itself;

6th line - Dimensions - use a handtape or extending ruler to measure size;


7th line - Remarks - describe anything of interest - carvings, condition in general. A sketch of any particular feature of the stone.

8th line - Inscription - record the complete inscription. Write each line as it is on the stone.

Key to Second Form

Genealogical Summary - summary of genealogical details - Surname, forename, DOB - date of birth, DOD -date of death, relationship - either father, mother, etc. Photograph - colour photograph of each stone.


